




Public participation matrix



Integrated project planning matrix



Joint Statement on Guiding Principles

Inland navigation and environmental protection are closely interlinked and interdependent. Therefore, the International Danube Basin Commission, the International Salvage River Basin Commission and the International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River (ICPDR) have adopted the "Joint Statement on Guiding Principles" of inland navigation and environmental protection along the Danube and the Save river. The International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River has been working with the International Salvage River Basin Commission on the development of the Danube River Environment Protection Strategy since 2000. This joint document, consisting of three main sections (principles, guidelines and monitoring), was developed by the International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River (ICPDR) and the International Danube Basin Commission. The "Joint Statement" is a guiding document for the maintenance of existing waterways and the development of new waterway infrastructure. It provides a principle that leads to the integration of ecology into every decision.



Critical sector FUTOG – **available depths, August 2012**


