NEWADA duo in a nutshell

NEWADA duo is an EU project - successor of NEWADA - funded under the South-East Europe Transnational Cooperation Programme.

This project supports the waterway management authorities of the Danube riparian states in establishing shared quality standards and achieving a common level of service in waterway management along the Danube and its navigable tributaries.

This improved cooperation focusses on efficient and effective waterway infrastructure maintenance as well as customer-oriented services. The NEWADA duo approach of concerted waterway and information management procedures will translate into new benefits for the users ensured beyond national borders.

The international project is yet another milestone in the process of enhancing the cooperation between the waterway authorities in the Danube region.
